SYMPTOMS AT ONSET

Excruciating pain in epigastric region Radiating to Back –“Not responding to analgesics

Breathlessness < Least exertion

Difficult movements due to pain / Fatigue ?

Frequent, loose, mucoid, dark blackish, offensive ++ Stools urine Output

Weight Loss - 12 kg over 4 mths.

Tachycardia / Hypotension

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Huge Ascites with PD leak

Lt. Pleural Effusion

Grossly Altered Physical Generals.

Poor General Condition



Abd. Girth (Standing) –“ 76 cm.

Bad Prognostic Criteria

Hypotension

Tachycardia

Hepatic Parenchymal Disease

G.I. Bleed

Grading as per Severity Index

Grade IV

(2 or more peri pancreatic fluid collections)

Ascites Lt Pleural Effusion

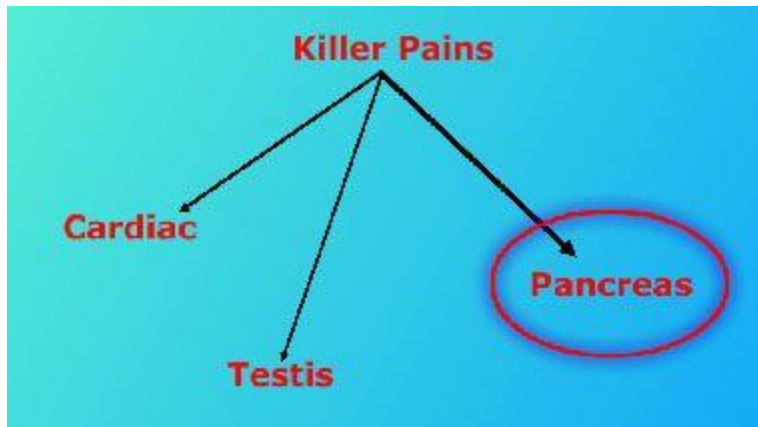

Much > in Gen. for 1 day, again < Sense of Well being established

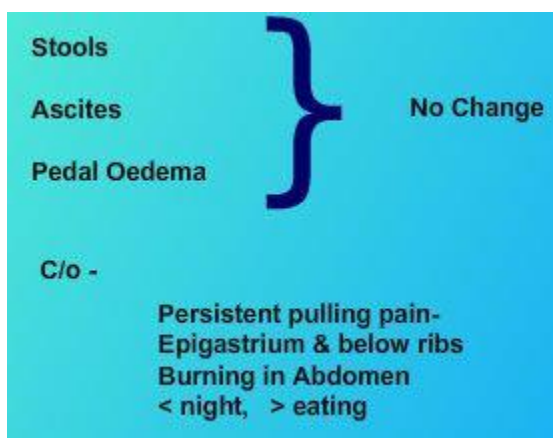
